5. Old Business
 - a. Raising the pistol berm height and filling in the “gap” on pistol bay 1.

 - b. We have installed a fire alarm system that will notify the fire department in case of a fire and no one is at the club.
System is installed and will be activated Thursday
 - c. Burglar alarm: Being installed and activated Thursday
 - d. Gutter guards – on hold
 - e. Income taxes have been filed for 2019.
 - f. Due to someone trying to kick in the door to the closet in the clubhouse, we will be installing a few cameras in the clubhouse.
6. New Business
 - a. We have made a modification to the club guest policy. It was brought to our attention that to be a regular club member, you must be 21 years of age. A club member, has an individual, (in this case a family member, nephew) who is 18, has firearms and wants to shoot. His immediate family has no interest in shooting or joining the club. Because we are about fostering an interest in the safe use and handling of firearms, especially younger and new shooters, we felt that this unfairly limits folks in that age bracket.
We are removing the limit of “2 visits per guest” for those guests, under the age of 21.
Additionally we also will not enforce the “2 visits limit” for those folks on the waiting list.
All other rules concerning guests will remain in effect. Posted rules will be updated shortly.
7. Legislative Updates – Delaware legislature will be back in session in early June. They are doing it “remotely” which means we have to be extra vigilant about what is going on. Contact you legislators to let your voice be heard.
