Old Business –

- a. As of June 1 “normal” business – guests ok, maintain social distance from the other parties. Face mask outside optional, talk from 10 foot separation, wash hands with soap and water, if sneeze or cough cover mouth with inside of elbow. **Anything inside Clubhouse – mask mandatory, maintain 6 foot social distancing.** Matches have been running as scheduled. Match director will determine outside mask wearing rules. **If do not feel well, please stay home and take care of yourself, even if just think it is a common cold.**

- b. Raising the pistol berm height and filling in the “gap” on pistol bay 1 is set to begin. Keystone concrete will start phase 1. Walls will be delivered in 3 to 4 weeks. Footing will be excavated and poured to set walls on. Range will be closed during these construction operations/ activities. Cost is approximately \$19,000. Hopefully in the spring, cost of pressure treated lumber will come down and the next phase can be planned.
- c. Burglar and fire alarms installed. Fire company will be called if there is an activation.
- d. Gutter Guards – on hold, discussion about removing. Placing ice stops on roofing. The grade would have concrete or stone type base and be designed to take water to designated drainage area. Discussion of overall drainage of club property. Will look into improvements.
- e. Due to someone kicking in the closet door, more cameras will be installed. Looking for price for two cameras. Price for system upgrade not available at this time.
- f. Dues renewals have been sent out. So far we have had a lot of folks renew. Remember the deadline is OCTOBER 31. Late fee will apply for any renewals after that date. If do not renew by December 31, you will be dropped from membership rolls. You will receive email with new code and year sticker. November 1 your card will be de-activated if no payment received.
- g. CMP has been completed. It was explained that an errant e-mail was sent due to the CMP merging an email list that should not have been used. Club is in good standing
- h. Nominations for club officers/ BOD positions are now open. If you would like to run for an office please let us know. All positions are open. John Wesolowski has been nominated for Chief Training and Range Officer. Current officers will run for their positions. Voting will be at the October meeting for members present at the meeting
