## Old Business –

- a. New web page project. Working on a new web page that is easier to use for members, club officers, match directors, etc. Peggy Walton updated this project. Still looking to change. A goal is to make the page a “place to go to”, see the website, liven the format up. Spotlight information about club events, events elsewhere, members participating in events in other areas/ regions, matches in other areas, top performers at events, etc. Moving the web site is a work in progress. Tim Perry has found an on line site for renewals next year. Thank you Peggy and Tim for this work.
- b. A question came up in the BOD meeting as to what to do about members who are LE or have a carry permit. They arrive at range with a loaded firearm. The club rules state the range is “cold” at all times – unless and until member is on the firing line and that firing line has been declared “HOT”. A “unloading station” is needed. Once this is finalized, communication will go out.
- c. As a solution to clogged gutters, at some point gutters will be removed. Stone will placed on back side of building to prevent erosion.
- d. Cast bullet clinic. Wes will hold a clinic on casting bullets in October. He will also have a reloading clinic in fall. Look on web page for more information
- e. The club donated \$2000 to each of 3 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights organizations to help defray court costs of lawsuits to protect our 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights

## New Business

- a. Due to the recent U.S. Supreme Court decision eliminating the “Good and Substantial” reasoning for carry concealed firearms; there has been a huge increase in need for use of range for people to complete the training. A committee has been formed for purpose of vetting instructors, rules for use of Bay 3 and scheduling classed. Club bylaws state to provide safe education. Mike Fisher ([MEFISHER56@gmail.com](mailto:MEFISHER56@gmail.com)) is chairing the committee. Bay 3 will be busy. Wear and Carry requires 8 hours classroom and 8 hours range time. Limiting instructors to 3 – 5 total.
- b. The work hour deadline is August 1 to reduce next year’s dues. After August 1 the hours will be for the following year. As always make sure you log your hours.
- c. Thank you letter received from Washington College Trap and Skeet team for club donation of \$2500
- d. Club shirts will be hung up in club. Please communicate if you are interested. If enough interest is generated, orders will be taken. Orders will need to be paid ahead of time, prices will be posted.
- e. Peggy and Jeff ask that if you want an event posted on the calendar; an email for the point of contact be provided
- f. Increasing the number of women in the club, and women participating in club events was brought up. This received positive discussion with some contacts to setup events.
- g. The video of two ATF agents and Delaware State Trooper knocking on a door asking for the serial numbers of two recently purchased handguns was brought up. If there is not any search warrant, it is suggested a respectful no be stated.

## Legislative updates:

- a. Maryland: elimination of the good and substantial reason as part of Governor Hogan responding to SCOTUS ruling
- b. Delaware: Done screwing with us until January and next legislative session
- c. Federal – House passed assault weapons ban Friday July 29. Keep an eye on them.
- d. National – Some states have added to where cannot carry etc. Know the laws where you are going.

- e. Encourage members to donate to organizations that defend the 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment. The club may entertain a matching amount up to certain dollar amounts and if documented. Also please keep yourself informed on the legislatures and there bills
