

Practical Battle Rifle Match (2-Gun)

Date: Sunday April 13, 2025

Setup: 0800

Match Starts: 0930



This will be a 2-gun match. (Pistol & Rifle)

Stage 1: 50 yards (pistol standing)

Stage 2: 75 yards (rifle sitting or kneeling)

Stage 3: 100 yards (rifle prone)

Ammo count if shot clean:

Pistol= (15 yards) 14 rounds if shot clean. Bring extra ammo and magazines.

Rifle= (75 yard) 14 rounds if shot clean. Bring extra ammo and magazines.

Rifle= (100 yards) 16 rounds if shot clean. Bring extra ammo and magazines.

Remember:

Only eight (8) rounds allowed in the rifle magazines and seven (7) rounds in the pistol magazines.

Cost is \$10.00 for the match.

Course of fire: All stages will be timed.

Stage 1. Shooter starts at the pistol table with a holstered empty pistol, hands on the table. At the buzzer, unholster pistol. Load a magazine and engage targets S1 thru S4 and T1 thru T5 at the shooter's discretion. Pistol will be placed back into the holster for safety. Use the command "If finished, show clear, if clear hammer down, holster" (Same commands as Steel Challenge and USPSA). Any deviation from this procedure will result in a match DQ. Targets will be scored and added to the time of the stage. Each missed steel plate will add 5 seconds to your time, and the target will be scored 0,1,3,5.

Stage 2. (Sitting or Kneeling) At the buzzer, load an empty rifle and engage the wheels of the jeep and trailer first. S1-S4. After all wheels are down, engage the five targets in the jeep and trailer with 2 shots each. Targets will be scored and added to the time of the stage. Each missed steel plate will add 5 seconds to your time, and the target will be scored 0,1,3,5.

Stage 3. (Prone) At the buzzer, load an empty rifle and engage the boat motor S1. (RED) **You cannot continue until the boat is disabled.** Once the boat is disabled, engage T1 thru T6 and S2 thru S4 at the shooter's discretion. Each missed steel plate will add 5 seconds to your time, and the targets will be scored 0,1,3,5.

This match is open to classes (1,3,4,5,6 open sights and scoped). No bolt actions this month.
All rifles must have an action indicator installed in the receiver going to and from the firing lines.

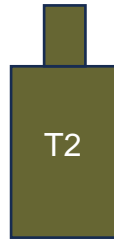

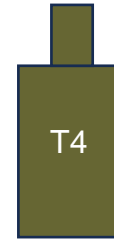
Pistol Stage
15 yards



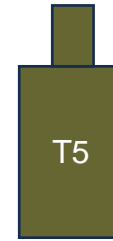

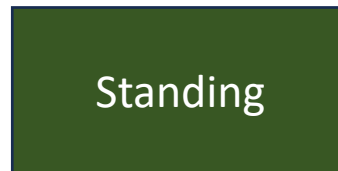

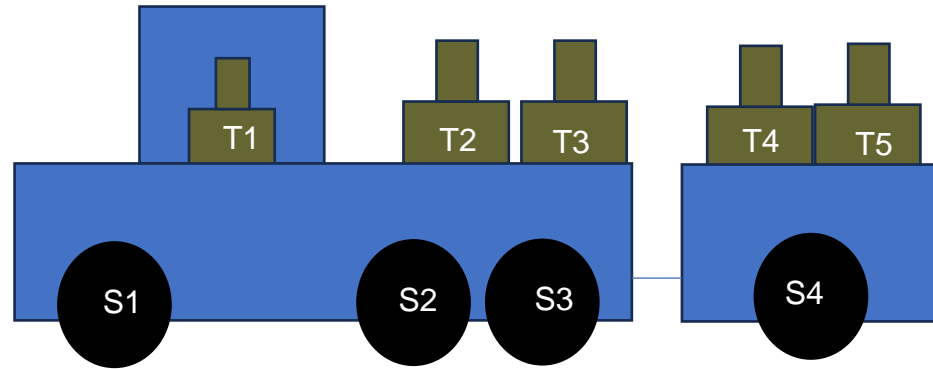

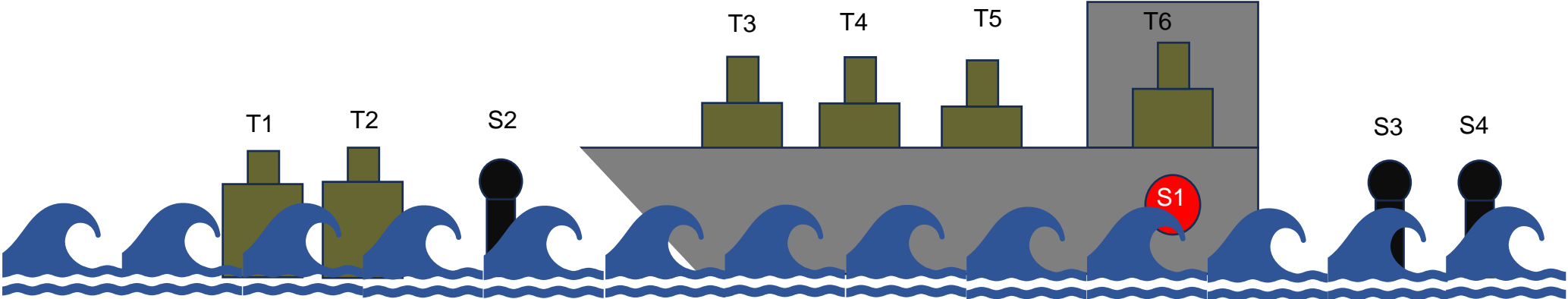


Rifle Stage
